

How to correctly enter the acquisition price for injectables:

1. Obtain the price you pay to purchase a package thru Oncology Supply
2. Divide the package price by the package size to obtain the unit price.
3. Divide the unit price by the size of the unit to get the acquisition price to enter in the drug record.

EXAMPLE:

Arixtra 5mg/0.4ml syringe

Package purchase price thru Oncology Supply is \$154.32 (package has 2 syringes in the box)

Divide the package price by the number of syringes (or vials) in the package to determine how much each one costs. For this example each syringe costs \$77.16

Each syringe is 0.4ml (this shows in the 'Package' field)

Divide \$77.16 by 0.4 to determine what 1 ml costs (\$192.90)

Enter \$192.90 in the acquisition field on the drug record
